


Reschedule planned order with Schedule mode referenced

The **Schedule mode referenced** will not only reschedule referenced production orders, but also referenced planned production orders shown in the resource planning of Axtension® Production Planning

The **Cluster Select** action is now moved and placed as Schedule mode **Cluster**.




Visualize intercompany production orders


This release of Axtension® Production Planning introduces the ability to visualize intercompany production orders exploded out of a project related production order.

The visualization is added to the task planning of Axtension® Project Management.

To visualize an intercompany production order, open the task planning of Axtension® Project Management and enable the **Production order** toggle and the **Show intercompany production order** toggle.



Enabling the **Show intercompany production orders** toggle will show intercompany production orders in the project task plan with the total duration of the production order and with the legal entity code as a prefix.



Note: Intercompany production orders are visualized from the start date until the end date of the production order. Individual operations of production orders are not visualized.
